

Rules for the use of the logo of the United Nations Conference on Climate Change COP19/CMP9

Article 1.

The Ministry of the Environment is the sole owner of the logo of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change COP19/CMP9, hereinafter referred to as the Logo.

Article 2.

1. The Logo may be used solely for the promotion of the Conference in Poland and across the globe.
2. The Logo shall be protected pursuant to the regulations of the Act on copyrights and related rights and the regulations of the Civil Code.
3. The use of the Logo on one's own products or information and promotion materials, always requires a permission granted by an authorised person from the Ministry of the Environment.

Article 3.

1. A licence for the Logo use shall be a one-off licence and it shall apply to a specific promotion material, product or service.
2. Given its purpose, as defined in Article 2(1), the licence shall be granted free of charge.
3. The Ministry of the Environment reserves the right to control the implementation of the permission for the Logo use by an entity that was granted the permission and to withdraw the permission in case when the entity fails to meet the conditions included in the granted permission or in these Rules.
4. An entity that was granted the permission to use the Logo shall be obliged to abide by the graphical requirements, as specified in the visual identification system.

Article 4.

1. The entity that applies for the award of the permission for the Logo use shall submit an application in writing of an authorised person to the Ministry of the Environment in accordance with the template attached in Appendix 1 to these Rules.
2. The submission of an application shall be understood as acceptance of these Rules.
3. A permission for the Logo use will be submitted together with an appropriate logotype and rules for the COP19 Logo use to the applicant's address. The template is attached to these Rules as Appendix 2.

Article 5.

The Ministry of the Environment has the right to amend these Rules at any time, but the amendments shall enter into effect on the day of announcement, i.e. the day of publication on the www.cop19.gov.pl website, unless decided otherwise by the Ministry of the Environment.
